Each text is followed by 2 multiple-choice (four-option) questions (there are 6 questions altogether). Part 2: A text from which seven relatively short paragraphs have been removed and placed in a jumbled order, together with an extra paragraph, after the text. Part 3: A longer text followed by seven multiple-choice (four-option) questions. 20 items altogether duration: 50 minutes weighting: 20% 	<p>Part 1: Summary</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> two topic-related texts (each 200 – 250 words long) and a summary task requiring students to write a summary of one of the ideas discussed in the texts ; length: 60 – 80 words the instruction clearly specifying that students must use their own words in the summary to make them employ paraphrase ('paraphrasing abilities' as a separate category in the rating scale) duration: 45 minutes weighting: 10% <p>Part 2: Essay</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> students answer one question from a choice of three questions text types: essay (opinion; suggesting solutions to problems; speculating about the casues) the format of the tasks: a topic without the expected essay type specified, each phrased in no more than 50 words length: 300 – 350 words duration: 75 minutes weighting: 25% 	<p>Part 1: Use of English</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> an achievement test, consisting of tasks including items based on content of the practical English course test in a standardized form: [1] vocabulary gap filling with some of the letters provided [2] keyword gap-filling (sets of three sentences to be completed with the same word) [3] word formation [4] sentence transformation with a key word provided [5] modified open cloze duration: 35 minutes weighing: 15% <p>Part 2: Translation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A short (100-110 words) non-specialist text (e.g. from general-interest journals, general textbooks) in Polish to be translated into English. students are required to demonstrate their ability to translate from Polish into English with the aid of a general monolingual and a bilingual (Polish-English) dictionaries. The focus of the translation is both grammatical and lexical precision, as well as appropriate content transfer. duration: 25 minutes weighing: 10% 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 parts: [1] warm-up; [2] individual long turn (based on a prompt with two suggestions) and follow-up questions / comments; [3] two-way follow-up discussion on topics relating to the prompts duration: 12 minutes per pair (16 minutes per a group of three) weighting: 20%

Further issues concerning marks and results:

- The following criteria are applied in order for a student to pass the exam:

- 65% or more as the total average in all four Modules;
- If at least 2 Modules are failed; the student fails the whole exam
- In case of a failing grade, the student re-sits only those Modules in which he/she did not reach the 65% threshold
- if 1 Module is failed (<65%), the final grade cannot be higher than 4 (dobry)

- The overall marks are converted into grades according to the following scheme:

Grade	Overall score

<i>dobry+</i>	82% - 89%
